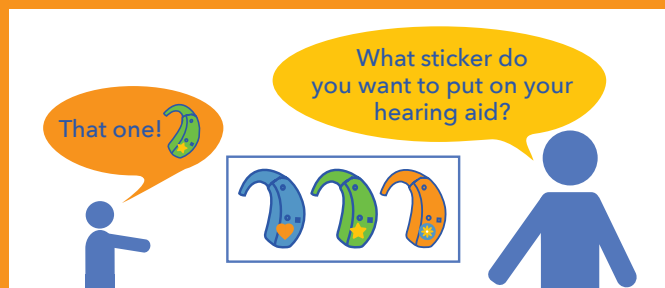


INVOLVING YOUNG CHILDREN IN HEARING HEALTH CARE

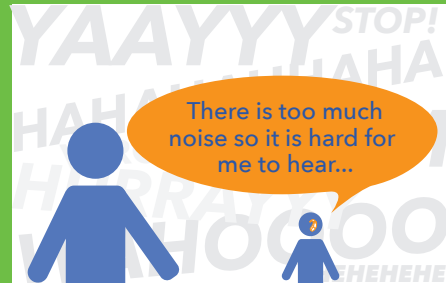
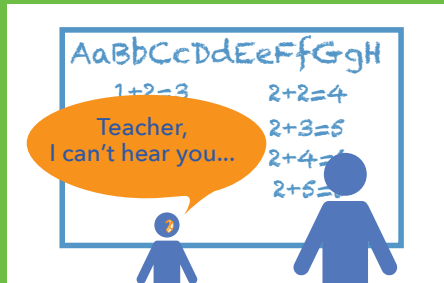
